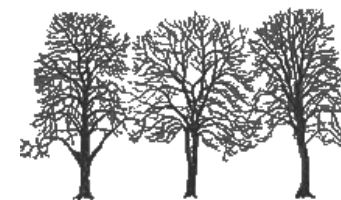

Is there a difference between Branch membership and membership in MGS?

The Manitoba Genealogical Society (MGS) is the provincial organization that promotes genealogical research across the province.

The Southeast & Winnipeg Branch is one of 5 local branches of MGS, each created to bring genealogists together, wherever we live in Manitoba. Branches maintain local resource libraries and provide education.

Because the Southeast & Winnipeg Branch shares office space in the MGS Resource Centre, we have merged our Branch Library with the provincial resource.

Our Branch focuses efforts on the provision of educational opportunities & programming for our members.

The Southeast & Winnipeg Branch of the Manitoba Genealogical Society Inc. was formed in 1979 under the by-laws of the Society to provide opportunities for persons interested in family history in Winnipeg and the Southeastern area of Manitoba to share experiences, assist one another, and expand their research skills.

Branch Objectives:

The objectives of the Southeast & Winnipeg Branch are to work locally to achieve the Society's objectives:

- Collection and preservation of genealogical and historical records and materials;
- Foster education in genealogical research through workshops, programming, and seminars; and
- Encourage production of genealogical publications relating especially to Manitoba.

Membership in the Southeast & Winnipeg Branch is open to all members of MGS for a small additional yearly fee.
